- Get Familiar with MSCA PF essential info (key purpose of MSCA PF grants, different types of MSCA PF grants, eligibility, statistics, important documents to consider).
- Understand the winning profile of MSCA PF projects, evaluation process, feedback from evaluators.
- What are the research ideas in MSCA PF that have stronger weight?
- How to formulate innovative objectives with clear evidence beyond the state of the art.
- How to describe the best methodology that is novel but at the same time the most appropriate for reaching your research objectives and your vision as researcher.
- How to show the best supervision for your MSCA grant (including access to essential resources and support measures from the host institution).
- How to suggest top-notch training and supervision support for excelling in your MSCA PF grant.
- How to present your CV in relation to the research project; what should not be forgotten, what is
 essential in the CV section, how to present it.
- What type of expected outcomes (short-term benefits) and impacts (long-term benefits) to suggest and how to build a convincing DEC strategy for achieving them.
- How to identify credible and measurable societal, economic and scientific wider impacts and suggest a proper strategy for achieving them.
- How to build the most appropriate workpackage structure and how to plan adequate resources for achieving the targeted objectives.
- How to deal with risks successfully (Research and administrative ones).
