


**Excellent Science (Pillar 1):** reinforcing and extending the excellence of the EU's science base

### MSCA in a nutschell



## Postdoctoral Fellowships

Submission by researcher in liaison with host institution

Enable talented researchers to work on individual projects to boost research and innovation potential

Researchers (with PhD) of any nationality

### **Doctoral Networks**

Submission by international consortium

Promote innovative research and doctoral training in Europe.
Developing researchers' skills for innovation within and outside academia.

Project proposals from a network offering doctoral programmes in and outside academia incl. joint & industrial doctorates

### **Staff Exchange**

Submission by international consortium

Stimulate international and intersectoral mobility and enhancing international dimension of research and innovation

A joint research and innovation project by the exchange of individual staff to ensure transfer of knowledge

#### **COFUND**

Monobeneficiary – one organisation

Support regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in research and career development of researchers

Organisations that fund or manage doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes for researchers.

## MSCA and CITIZENS

Submission by one organisation or consortium

Boosting public awareness of the positive role of research in society – especially among young people

Beneficiaries can be private or public research org., universities, companies, public authorities, schools, museums, NGO...

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# About POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS

### Rules in a nutshell







### researcher

- Project by an individual researcher
- max. 8 of research experience from date of award of the (first) doctoral degree
- Mobility rule: The researcher cannot have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 12months in the last three years prior to the call deadline

+

### host organisation

- located in EU member state or Horizon Europe associated country
- Public or private research organisation, university, research centre, international European interest organisation, international organisation, industry, SMEs (any sector)

### Rules in a nutshell



### **European fellowship**

- Project realized at a host institution located in EU MS or AC
- Researcher of any nationality
- Duration: 12-24 months

### **Global fellowship:**

- Large part of the project realized at a non-European institution
- Researcher needs to be a national or long-term resident of a EU MS or AC
- Duration: 24-36 months
  - √ 12-24 months out of Europe
  - ← 12 months mandatory reintegration phase in a EU MS or AC

### Impact section of your project

### - in a nutshell

MSCA-NET

- impact on career
  - enhancement of the career of the postdoctoral fellow
- dissemination, exploitation and communication activities
  - of the project and its results
- impact on the wider scientific field, broader societal and economic implications
  - how will our knowledge be advanced by this project
  - how can it be relevant to the diverse stakeholder communities, policy-making, industry etc.

#### **REMEMBER:**

impact weights 30% of your overall score



### **Practical tips**



- Start writing early enough you will rewrite your proposal over and over
  - several months before the deadline
- Ensure cooperation with the supervisor/host institution
  - you will need a lot of information
- Make a checklist with all evaluation criteria
  - respond all of them dilligently
- Use the call-specific Standard application form available in the Submission System
- Let others (non-experts as well) read your proposal
  - they must at least get a clue what your proposal is all about
  - test your proposal with different audiences colleagues, collaborators, your future supervisor and perhaps some of his colleagues, project office at your host institute
- See if you can get a proofreading help from MSCA NCP
