



Abstract

The Chu ci, the earliest anthology of Chinese romantic poetry by Qu Yuan and other poets, contains a large number of flower and plant names which have both referential and symbolic meanings. These meanings are so difficult to identify and determine today as to bring about great trouble in understanding and representing the names in translation. This article briefly explores the double meaning of some flower and plant names in the Li sao, the most important poem in the anthology, and examines the translation methods used in the English versions of the canon by Yang Xianyi and Gladys Yang, David Hawkes, Xu Yuanchong, and Zhou Zhenying. The present study holds the philosophy of translation that any translating experiment is advisable in dealing with the names if their appropriate cultural connotations can be made clear.

Keywords: Chu ci, Flower and plant names, Cultural connotations, Translation methods

Introduction

The Chu ci (楚辞), or The Songs of the South, is an anthology of ancient Chinese poems by Qu Yuan and other poets which was produced during the Warring States period (5th century B.C.-221 B.C.) and the Han dynasty (202 B.C.-220 A.D.). "Chu" and "ci" in the title mean the "State of Chu" (one of the kingdoms of the Eastern Zhou dynasty) and "verse" or "song" respectively, and thus "Chu ci" means "verses of Chu" or "songs of Chu". As the most important poet of the Chu ci, Qu Yuan was a loyal minister of the King Huai of Chu, but was banished by the latter due to the slanders of Qu's rivals, and Qu created most of his great poems as a depressed loner in exile.

The Chu Ci and Its Plant Names

The anthology contains 17 poems according to The Verse and Chapter of the Chuci (1985) by Wang Yi [1], the earliest, authoritative Chuci commentator of the Eastern Handynasty (see Table 1). Some

of these poems are actually a collection of poems. For example, the Jiu ge consists of 11 pieces, including "Donghuang taiyi" (东皇太一, "The Great Unity, God of the Eastern Sky"), "Yunzhong jun" (云中君, "The Lord Within the Cloud"), "Xiang jun" (湘君, "The Goddess of the Xiang"), "Xiang furen" (湘夫人. "The Lady of the Xiang"), "Da siming" (大司命, "The Great Master of Fate"), "Shao siming" (少司命, "The Lesser Master of Fate"), "Dong jun" (东君, "The Lord of the East"), "He bo" (河伯, "The River Earl"), "Shan gui" (山鬼, "The Mountain Spirit"), "Guo shang" (国殇, "Hymn to the Fallen"), and "Li hun" (礼魂 "Honoring the Dead").

As the first romantic anthology of poetry in Chinese literature, the Chu ci is characterized by strong local color, various gods and spirits, elegant language, rich imagination, and especially the poet's love of his native country and his king, his hatred of evil-hearted courtiers, his worries of his motherland's fate, and his sympathy for

Concluding Remarks

It is no doubt that all Chinese and foreign translators will encounter great difficulties in rendering flower and plant names in the Chu ci, and thus any translating experiment is welcome in this regard. Only when translators get a thorough understanding of the names through an extensive reading and an in-depth study of all important *Chu ci* commentaries in Chinese history will they not get lost in translation when dealing with "the murky allegory that pervades many passages" in the canon Watson [2].

Introduction

Birds are very strange. Some people are like "whoa they're flying around and stuff, what's the deal with that?" This sentiment is shared by people across socioeconomic backgrounds. Figuring out what the deal is with birds is of the utmost scientific importance. It is now widely appreciated that the majority of socially monogamous passerine species are weird [1]. In species with moderately high extra-pair mating and paternal care, we need to understand what is going on with them [2]. In territorial species, what are they even doing [3] and they do all sorts of weird stuff [4] (but see [5]). Material and Methods

Study species and general field methods

I looked at three different birds: a woodpecker, a parrot, and a penguin. I looked really close at them, squinting and everything, to try and figure out what was up with them. I conducted these experiments at our long-term study site in Samsonvale, Queensland (GPS = 27°16'S, 152°51'E). Detailed population monitoring and paternity assignment methods are described elsewhere [10]. Briefly, I watched them really close for quite a while [13-15]. To eliminate potential confounds, I thus conducted my experiments only on animals that I knew for sure were birds, and no other things

Repeatability of weird behaviors

I used three subsets of the data to analyze repeatability in male response across the multiple trials. Because the PCA data were non-Gaussian, I calculated repeatability using an overdispersed binomial GLMM in the R v3.1.1 [20] package rptR [21]. First, I chose the subset of males that received all six treatments (N = 44 males, six trials per male), and calculated repeatability in aggression

behaviors as the response variable, and average Aggression PC1 and trial date as fixed effects. For this model, I used the two-trial dataset for males with at least one successful nest (N = 35). Similarly, I analyzed duetting using the same model, but with average Duet PC1 and trial date as fixed effects. For this model, I used the twotrial, female-present dataset for males with at least one successful




Figure 1: Relationships between climate change (a), looks like a fish (b), and weird beak. X-values were scaled between 0 and 1 for visualization purposes.

Discussion

This is the first study I am aware of to attempt to quantify the deal with birds. Unfortunately, the results were ambiguous, although Bayesian approaches may prove useful in the future. This study has implications for climate change research. When presented with weird behavior, birds exhibited a multimodal response including physical aggression and duetting, both of which were repeatable across highly variable contexts. Even when including behavioral responses to heterospecific mounts and songs, which elicited relatively weak responses [19], repeatability in both behaviors was Ethics significant. This pattern suggests that although males modify their aggressive and vocal responses to intrusions representing varying threat levels, there are consistent among-individual differences in both of these behaviors (i.e., personality [22-24]). The repeatable nature of these behaviors suggests that they serve an important function, and here we examined the possibility that they are part of Data Accessibility a behavioral strategy to ensure paternity.




Figure 1: Get me off your fucking mailing list.

Aggression did not have a significant effect on cuckoldry rate (Figure 1a), suggesting that more aggressive males are not successful at deterring rivals from intruding on their territories in search of EPCs. Alternatively, despite the fact that males are often observed foraying during the day, EPCs are rarely observed [11,12], Conflict and may occur pre-dawn, as has been observed in other fairy-wrens [25,26]. demonstrated in species such as Australian magpie-larks [29,30] and Costa Rican plain wrens [31]. Importantly, these hypotheses are not mutually exclusive, and duetting may serve multiple functions in the same species. In RBFW, there is strong support for territory establishment and defense, but the results presented here suggest that duetting also influences cuckoldry rates. More detailed observations of which pair member initiates a duet, and how answer rates affect cuckoldry are necessary to tease apart the various mechanisms discussed here, and are forthcoming [32].




Figure 2: Get me off your fucking mailing list.










Prenos podatkov o gradivu iz Google Učenjak v EndNote





*Abstract:

Purpose: Paper presents a portal for browsing the University of Maribor Library (UML) digitised materials. The outline and contents design of the UML Digital Repository (DR UKM) as well as the software platform and the technical solutions are presented. The thematic collections for promotion of Maribor and Štajerska cultural heritage are emphasized. An emphasis is put on the presentation of the metadata scheme, in which the metadata for DR UKM are consistent with the COMARC/B format. Usage and licence information are also provided. The article stresses the repository's usability, as the digitised

materials are available for different public and different purposes, like teaching, research or simply browsing.

Methodology/approach: After examining good practice examples and due to the necessity of providing the UML materials also in digitised form, we decided to establish the DR UKM. An outline and contents design were prepared, collections to be digitised were selected, the software platform, the interface, and the metadata scheme, which enables connectivity with other systems in open access, were prepared.

Results: A portal for browsing the UML digitised materials with the emphasis on open access to cultural heritage, which can be connected to other digital repositories, was established. With the DR UKM the UML contributes to shaping the virtual world of

knowledge; with digitising precious cultural heritage of the university, the city and the region it ensures a wide access to cultural goods.

Originality/practical implications: The DR UKM was built by the University of Maribor professionals' own knowledge. It offers a wider accessibility and it protects rare and antiquarian materials 24/7; it also enables cooperation among libraries on the national and local level. Exchange of information and digitised objects as well as their searching

are simplified.




